## **CATECHISM CORNER**

## January 22<sup>nd</sup> – Day of Prayer For the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22<sup>nd</sup> shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord's help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

On June 24, 2022, the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* decision overturned *Roe v. Wade*, and we praise God for the great opportunity state and federal legislators now have to protect pre-born children. While God, in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide regime of abortion on demand, right now state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to pre-born children. So, great prayer and advocacy is very needed.

Remember, the unborn are only one of many Respect Life Issues: Sexism, racism, death penalty, diversity, sex trade, misogynism (treating women like objects), hate, lying and many more. March for Life is inclusive, not just one.


