Sacrament of Marriage

- Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for holiness, for they will be satisfied.

Am I passionate for the things of God? Do I work for the triumph of love, peace and justice?

- *Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.*When I am wronged, am I willing to forgive? Am I currently holding any grudges against anyone?
